1. Position the motorcycle securely on its center (main) stand.




Pright and Left side of motorcycle is determined while sitting on the bike.

INSTALLATION

For installation of Z5360 to left side of R1200 GS, first remove the left body panel.


1. Remove the stock plug. (Flat Blade Screw Driver) Figure 1



2. Place ZPlug into position and tap on. (Rubber Mallet) Figure 2

MAINTENANCE

Clean as you would your motorcycle.

REMOVAL OF THE ZPLUG

If necessry to remove the ZPlug use the tool provided. Gently push the tool between the frame of the motorcycle and the ZPlug. Work the tool around the Plug, slowly pulling the ZPlug straight out. **Do not use the tool to pry the plug out.**

If removal is difficult, push the tool between the Plug and the frame of the motorcycle then insert a long Flat Blade Screw Driver to work the Plug out. Never pry directly on the ZPlug with a screw driver, doing so can damage the ZPlug.
